Time limit: 1st string: Unlimited Sighters for three minutes, then 22 minutes for 2 convertible sighting shots and 20 rounds on score.
2nd and 3rd string: 22 minutes for 2 convertible sighting shots and 20 rounds on score.

PRIZE PRESENTATION FOLLOWING:

Awards in each category including:

Any Rifle, Iron Sight, F Class Open, F Class F/TR, F Class Sporter Rifle and Bench.
There must be at least 3 entries in any given category to qualify for awards.

RIFLES: Any Rifle, Iron Sight, or
F Class, or
Bench Rifle

CALIBRE: Any calibre up to 300 Win Mag. (No muzzle brakes Allowed)

RULES: Visit www.icfra.com for TR and F Class rules. ICFRA Targets will be used.

Rules For Sporter Rifle Category:

- Rifles shall be centre-fire bolt-action used as single-shot (removable magazines must be removed from rifle);
- Rifle must be equipped with factory original action, barrel and trigger (trigger may be adjusted but not less than ½ kg (1.1 lbs), however custom stocks may be used;
- Factory-built target rifles such Savage F-Class or Palma, Remington 40X or XR100 or similar are not permitted (Match Director shall have final say as to acceptability);and,
- Total rifle weight including Optics and attachments (e.g. bipod)is not to exceed 5.45 kg (12 lbs)
